

NEO SUMMER CAMP COUNSELOR JOB DESCRIPTION & QUALIFICATIONS

1. Be a Christ-follower and actively involved in a local church.
2. Desire to work as a Christian leader with children in outdoor programs.
3. Have the ability to participate fully in all activities of the camp program.
4. Be able to accept constructive criticism from directors.
5. Be flexible in attitude and willing to work at many different tasks including kitchen work, clean-up, etc.
6. Follow all camp policies and procedures.
7. Age requirements:
 - Counselors: 18 years or older
 - Jr Counselors: 9th grade and up (14 years or older)

Before Camp:

1. Complete all counselor training.
2. Provide a recent background check to the camp.
3. Ensure that all required paperwork is submitted to camp at least 30 days before camp start dates.

During Camp:

1. Wake up with campers at designated time.
2. Actively participate in all activities with your campers. (Including meals and clean-up assignments and nightly services.)
3. Actively engage your campers in spiritual discussions and be aware of significant spiritual battles or breakthroughs that your campers are experiencing.
4. Regularly monitor your campers for signs and symptoms of illness.
5. Be in your assigned cabin during the night time hours.

After Camp:

1. Participate in camp clean up with your campers.
2. Stay at camp until all your campers have been released.
