Youth can stay in the youth lodging for those who come without family or youth leader.

YOUTH LODGE RULES

Students are to check-in & check-out with a SMB member on arrival/departure

Students must be registered for and attend the student ministries program

Lodging is \$25/night and includes meals

Students can stay from 3pm Sunday July 24 until 9pm Friday July 29

Students must agree to follow all campground, SMB, and counselor rules

Students must keep area tidy and shower daily

Students of opposite sex are NOT permitted in bunkrooms, restrooms or showers
