

CAMP HOUSING

- Youth can camp on the grounds with family.
- Youth can come camp with their youth leaders.
- Youth can stay in the youth lodging for those who come without family or youth leader (Supervision Provided)
- Students are NOT permitted to stay on campgrounds without adult supervision.

YOUTH LODGE RULES

- Students are to check-in & check-out with a SMB member on arrival & departure
- Students must be registered for and attend the student ministries program
- Lodging is \$32/night and includes meals. Camp registration is \$96 by June 15, \$116 after June 15.
- Students can stay from 3pm Sunday July 19 until 9pm Friday July 24
- Students must agree to follow all campground, SMB and counselor rules
- Students must keep area tidy and shower daily
- Students of opposite sex are NOT permitted in bunk rooms, restrooms, or showers.
- Students staying in lodge are required to attend offsite events

- Multiple pairs of shoes, at least one pair of tennis shoes
