Stay in the youth lodge with a chaperone and meals are provided. REGISTRATION REQUIREDTO PARTICIPATE.

Cell Phone Policy:

For safety and limiting distractions, students are not permitted to have their cell phones during ANY SERVICES, in the RESTROOMS or in CHANGING AREAS (bunk rooms).
